

Cleaning a DECRA® roof

Due to inevitable accumulation of dust, dirt and moisture on roof surfaces over time, it may become necessary to periodically clean your DECRA Roof.

To clean your roof, use a solution consisting of 1 part household chlorine bleach to 1 part water. This solution can be sprayed on the dirty area(s) with a garden sprayer. Leave the solution on for at least an hour and preferably overnight. Rinse the treated areas with pressurized water from a garden hose. A brush with soft bristles can also be used to remove stubborn spots. A professional cleaner may wish to use a pressure washer to clean large areas more quickly. To avoid damage to the roof coating, the pressure washer should be set at no more than 500 pounds per square inch (psi) water pressure.

Note: Care should be taken to protect trees, plants and grass areas from excessive run-off.
