Exciting News – Possible Annexation to the City of Palm Beach Gardens

We have been investigating the pros and cons of being annexed by the City of Palm Beach Gardens. The City has provided us with some initial information on what we can expect as written below and on the attached page. Calculations done by the City on some units show our property taxes will decrease. It all looks very promising, but we have much more work to do on the issue. Fire and Police Service

Fire Rescue is a full service agency offering Advanced Life Support, rescue service, fire suppression, fire safety and inspection services. The Fire Department is internationally accredited through the Commission on Fire Accreditation International and has an Insurance Services Office (ISO) Community Rating of Class 3. Fire Rescue operates out of 5 fire stations, outfitted with state of the art vehicles and equipment strategically located throughout the city to provide an exceptional level of service.

The Police Department is the law enforcement agency for the City of Palm Beach Gardens. The Department has a very supportive citizen base, state-of-the-art equipment and vehicles, and superior training. The Department is headed by a Chief of Police who is responsible to the City Manager for the operation of the Police Department. The Department is divided into two Divisions, the Administrative and Investigations Division and the Field Operations Division, which are each headed by an Assistant Chief. The Department has a tremendous volunteer force and interact with citizens in a variety of innovative and proactive ways.

Emergency Management

The Emergency Management team is responsible for developing, coordinating and leading the City's Emergency Management Program, enabling effective preparation for, and efficient response to, emergencies and disasters in order to save lives, reduce human suffering and reduce property loss. The Emergency Management team develops plans and procedures to ensure the highest levels of mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery; the maintains a comprehensive, risk-based, multi-hazard emergency management and training program; and they coordinate Federal, State and Local resources for mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery operations.

Parks and Recreation

Access to an excellent Recreational Department, exceptional City parks and recreational programs, and the City's municipal golf course, with lower park/rec fees

provided to City residents (see attached Parks & Rec Fees)
