

#### **Tennis/Pickleball Court Rules**

#### Parking/Guest Registration & Check-in:





Guests of residents using the courts may park in the Index parking lot provided they check in with the guards in their car and then circle back to the parking lot. This is to be done every visit.

#### **Court Time:**

When residents are waiting for a court, the group who has been on the court the longest must leave the court 1½ hours from the time they started using the court.

EXAMPLE: All courts are in use. The group playing the longest started playing at 9:00 am. A new group of people would like to play, so the group that started at 9:00 am must leave their court at 10:30 am. NOTE: Court time use does not start at the point new players arrive at the courts.

A single resident playing with guests may not occupy more than one court at a time, and each court in use must have at least one resident playing with their guests.

Example: If a resident invites seven guests to play on the courts. The resident and guests may only use one court rather than playing doubles on two courts or singles on three or four courts. If other residents are waiting for a court, the group with one resident and seven guests must give up the court 1½ hours from the time they started playing.

#### **Use of Courts:**

The courts are only to be used for playing tennis and pickleball

Dogs are NOT permitted on the courts or condo property. Dogs must be on a leash at all time when outside the dog owner's residence.

Skateboards, bikes, scooters, roller blades and all other similar wheeled vehicles are not permitted on the courts at any time.

The courts are not a play area for children. Any children on the courts must be with an adult and using the courts for playing tennis or pickleball.

#### **Court Etiquette:**

To avoid being a nuisance to players on other courts and owners in nearby town homes and condominiums, music MAY NOT be played on the courts at any time.

All trash must be removed from the courts when players leave the area.

Chairs, brooms and rollers should be returned to their appropriate storage location at the end of play.

The POA Property Manager should be contacted if any area of the court requires maintenance/repair or if equipment is missing, e.g., torn nets, straps and wind screens, missing chairs, broken water fountain.

# **Hurricane Preparation**

We are approaching the start of hurricane season. Hurricane shutters are the best investment you can make to protect your property and yourself. The Board encourages you to install approved hurricane shutters if you do not already have them.

BEFORE: a hurricane makes landfall shelter arrangements should be made if needed. Make arrangement for pets, install shutters, fill fuel tanks, freeze extra ice, fill tub with water, have a two-week supply of non-perishable food. Secure property by bringing outdoor items inside or properly securing (boat, trailers, etc.). Check trees and/or shrubbery, trim and remove limbs that could damage your house or utility lines. Trimming should be performed now, prior to hurricane announcement.

**DURING:** a hurricane stay inside at all times. Stay away from windows and exterior doors. In a one-story home, the strongest room is often a bathroom or walk-in closet near the center of the house, which is often best to be made Soap as a safe room.

**AFTER:** a hurricane make temporary repairs to protect your home. Contact your insurance & FEMA to place damage claims. Before hiring contractors verify their license & insurance with the Town of Jupiter Building Department (561)-741-2286.

### **Pet Reminders**

# **Approval Needed for All Exterior Alterations**

Remember to obtain written approval PRIOR to any and all exterior modifications, including but not limited to painting, replacing windows and/or doors, lighting, hurricane shutters, roofs, decorative items, landscaping, etc.

# **Guardhouse updates:**

House Keys at the Guardhouse: make sure that you have an extra set of keys secured at the guardhouse that they are current versions of your keys.
