The Board reviewed the August 2017 Financials and reviewed the delinquency report.

The Board reviewed the proposal in regards to the Sidewalk work.

MOTION: Karen Lampe made a motion seconded by John Petroff to hire PRF Services to work on the sidewalks and to provide a price to check the sidewalks every 6 months. The motion carried 4-0.

The hedges should not impose on walkways and need to be cut to the edge of the sidewalk, then straight up. They should not be cut at an angle.

The Board asked management to push forward on the work with the islands. Jeff Barbieri volunteered his time to help with the project.

Management announced that the Bat House project has been completed by the boy scouts.

Management presented a proposal from Ken Friedman to do the year end financials for Gardens Hunt Club. MOTION: John Petroff made a motion seconded by Karen Lampe to approve the contract from Ken Friedman. The motion carried 4 to 0.

The gazebo is falling apart. It was suggested that the gazebo be removed and find options for a swing set or a pavilion with a picnic table. Management will bid out the project.

There are complaints about some kids and a golf cart in the community. Management is gathering information to pursue the complaints.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 7:20 pm.
