## IMPORTANT

Many new fences have been installed and more are in process of being replaced and all the fences will be painted. Please remove all personal attachments from your fence. This includes but is not limited to: lights, hose holders, security cameras and decorations. Please remove all plant material between the fence and screen enclosure to keep the area clean and keep vines and plants from growing onto the fence. If the work has not been completed when painting starts, the Association will schedule the work and the unit owner will be billed.

## *Rule Reminders*

- ◆ Stones are not to be used on the common areas for plant beds.
- ◆ No plants with thorns are allowed to be planted.
- ◆ Multiple pots are not allowed to be placed in the common areas. This includes the areas around your fence.
- ◆ Nothing may be attached on the walls, fences or common areas.
- ◆ Boxes must be flattened prior to being taken to the dumpster. (see reverse side for the recycling pamphlet).
- ◆ Dumpster lids must be kept closed after use to stop animals entering.
- ◆ Pick up after your dog.
- ◆ Fruit trees, vegetable plants, etc. are not allowed in the community. Owners must remove them.
- ◆ Owners are required to keep their screens maintained. No ripped or torn screens. Clean when dirty or mold or leaves built up.

-  Plastic Bags

## Yellow Gets

-  Cardboard
  - Cut and flattened to 36-inches x 36-inches or less
-  Newspaper and Inserts
  - No plastic bags
-  Office and School Paper
-  Mail
-  Magazines
-  Dry Food Boxes
  - No food stains
-  Paper Bags
-  Cardboard Paper Rolls
-  Pizza Boxes
  - No food stains
