

JUPITER VILLAGE POOL
GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

SECTION I

Jupiter Village Pool Committee hereby declares that the following rules and regulations are in full force and effect, and said rules and regulations, which may be amended from time to time by Pool Committee shall govern the operation of the swimming pool.

1. Good conduct, proper attire, and decorum must be observed by owners and their guests at all times on the premises of the pool.
2. Pool Committee/Jupiter Village Home Owners Association is not responsible for any loss or damage to any property at the pool regardless of where such property is kept, left, or stored on the premises of the pool.
3. Each owner /or quest shall pay for any loss or damage caused to the property of the pool by such owner, his family or quests.
4. Parents are responsible for the conduct and safety of their children at all times.
5. No pets are allowed on or in the pool or pool premises at all times.
6. The pool Committee shall have the right to alter rules. The Pool Committee shall have the right to decide on availability of the facilities to various classifications and make all final decisions as to operation of facilities.
7. Owners shall be considered to be in good standing under these rules and regulations so long as they are neither delinquent in assessments to individual phase nor in violation of any rules and regulations promulgated by Pool Committee.

Section II

MEMBERSHIP: shall be available to owners of lots, or units or lessees of same Jupiter Village and the right to use of pool shall be extended to the Member's family. Membership includes spouse, all children living at home or attending school.

Section III

Members of Pool may invite non-resident guests to use the facilities at the pool, no more than SIX (6) times in one year subject to and limited by Rules And Regulations established from time to time by the Pool Committee for such use. Daily charges for quests may be imposed by the Pool Board Committee thereafter.

Section IV

Each lot owner and unit owner will be provided one key for admittance to the pool. These keys should not be duplicated. Loss of key will result in \$50.00 fee for replacement made payable to the Jupiter Village Homeowners Association.

Section V

1. SUSPENSION/TERMINATION: The Pool Committee, shall have absolute right, in it's sole discretion, to temporarily and /or to permanently terminate pool usage to a owner/family member/guest, if following occurs:

A. Any owner, family or guest, as defined above shall violate any Rules and Regulations for the use of facilities at Jupiter Village Pool as same may be modified from time to time by Pool Committee.

B. Notice: The Pool Committee shall be obligated to give fifteen days notice of violation to any owner, family member guest, as condition precedent to temporary suspension and /or permanent termination of pool facilities usage/priviledges by reason of such owner/family member/guest violation of these rules and regulations. Such notice may be given in writing by Pool Committee, upon receipt of such notice, the subject, individual (s) shall forthwith peacefully remove himself from Pool premises. Upon the suspension of any owner, the owner/family member shall not have priviledge of using the pool for any purpose and shall forfeit entrance key.

Suspension shall be for such period of time as Pool Committee may designate and the pool committee may establish such resonable requirements as it deems appropriate as a condition to the reinstatement of any owner, family member, or quest to good standing.

Section VI

Owners, family members, guests, shall be deemed terminated upon the resignation or expulsion of the owner holding key entrance priviledges.

Section VII

1. Bathing load : 26 persons at one time in water.
2. No lifeguard will be on duty: Swim at your own risk.
3. Children under fourteen (14) of age Must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Parents are reponsible for the conduct and safety of their children.
4. All persons must shower prior to entering pool.
5. Long hair must be tied back.
6. Any person who might have an "accident" must wear training pants under light rubber pants.
7. Running, rollerskating, ball playing or games are prohibited on Pool premise and in pool area.

9. No rafts, toys, or foreign objects of any kind whatsoever are permitted in the pool.
10. NO DIVING allowed, the deepest part of the pool is less than six feet due to resurfacing. and is not deep enough to dive in a safe manner.
11. NO animals, no glassware or bottles.
12. Every owner/family member or guest using the pool area is responsible for leaving the area in a clean and presentable manner.
13. Pool deck furniture may not be removed from pool area.
14. The Pool Committee, Pool Manager/Pool Monitors has complete authority to refuse to admit anyone because of health reasons, intoxication, mis -conduct, or disregard for the Rules and Regulation or disregard for the safety of any persons.
15. Pool and Pool Area shall be closed during inclement weather, and hours of operations are Tuesday thru Sunday 9A.M. - dusk, Monday 1P.M to dusk. Other restrictions in hours shall be established by the Pool Committee and Pool Monitor.
16. No one is to use the pool when it's officially designated as closed. Unauthorized use or violation of usage during closed periods will result in fines and prosecution.

Section VIII

Use of the Pool and its facilities by owners, family members and guests, invitees and licensees shall be at the risk of such user of the pool and its facilities.

Pool Monitors, Pool Managers are ~~not~~ lifeguards, but act as administrative, function to oversee Rules and Regulations. Pool Monitors have full authorization of Pool Committee to exercise administration of Rules and Regulations of Jupiter Village Pool.
