

Hurricane Irma Update, October 2017

Dear Neighbors and Residents,

Here is an assessment of the damage to Wyndham from Hurricane Irma, which hit us on Sept. 9-10, 2017:

- Two mailboxes were damaged at Oakwater. These have been repaired.
- About 2-4 trees will need to be replaced.
- Five smaller/newer trees fell over. These have been lifted and staked.
- Lots of branches and fronds covered the ground. These have (finally) been picked up.
- A pineapple light fixture at the entrance was broken. A new one has been ordered.
- A few FPL light fixtures were broken. FPL has been contacted.



Hurricane Irma ravaged parts of Florida, yet spared Wyndham and our area. Hurricane Maria, two weeks later, missed us completely. Before, during, and after the chaos, we saw neighbors helping neighbors - putting up shutters, taking down shutters, cutting up branches, cleaning up debris, and riding around offering help. We are very fortunate and very grateful. We are an amazing community.
