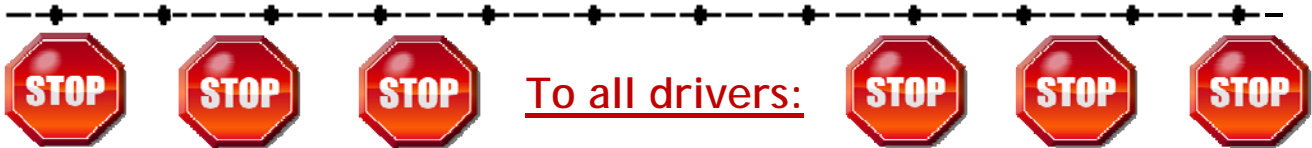

The swale trees were trimmed this month by the Brickman Company. A structural pruning was performed, according to their arborists, to ensure proper growth and shaping of the trees. No further trimming will be needed for at least another 18 months.
