The landscaper provided a proposal for Cocoplums to be added behind the Wakefield property. The board review the proposal and requested that larger plants be installed and to get a quote for the rest of ficus to be removed and installed with Cocoplum

The Board reviewed the proposal for the "No Swimming" signs and agreed to have 2 signs installed for the estimated cost of \$1,037.96.
