If you have not yet received an updated clicker from Sea Breeze, now is the time to do so - before your clicker stops working. Your first one is **free**: any more will cost \$30 each.




A friendly reminder to all homeowners that pets are not allowed on properties without the property-owner's explicit permission. Also, please pick up after your pets.
